# WORK/SPECIAL MEETING OF THE HILLSBOROUGH TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION April 12, 2010

The Board of Education of Hillsborough Township in the county of Somerset, convened in public session on Monday, April 12, 2010 at 6:30 p.m. in the cafeteria of the Auten Road Intermediate School in the School District.

# **Executive Session**

A motion was made by Mr. Hudes and seconded by Mr. Gillette that the board adopt a resolution to go into executive session at 6:32 p.m.

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, Chapter 231 of the Laws of 1975 provides that a public body may exclude the public from that portion of a meeting of which the public body discusses certain matters for which confidentiality is required as permitted in Section 7B of the act.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Township of Hillsborough in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The following matters to be discussed are negotiations with bargaining units, two employee settlement agreements, and non-renewal of non-tenured staff.
- 2. The matters discussed in executive session shall be disclosed to the public when the need for confidentiality no longer exists.

Upon call of the roll, the motion carried with a unanimous vote recorded.

Dr. Forsthoffer gave an updated budget presentation detailing the proposed budget cuts for non-staff related items to include: a 15% cut in supplies, high school co-curricular activities, high school and middle school sports, administrative cuts totaling 16.24%, and teaching cuts totaling 5.1%. Dr. Forsthoffer stated that there are sixty-six positions currently being reduced because the Hillsborough Education Association and the Principal's and Supervisor's unions have each reached tentative agreements containing concessions that will allow the board to restore twelve of the positions that were slated to be cut.

Dr. Forsthoffer concluded his presentation by thanking both unions for their contributions.

Time was allowed for questions and comments on the superintendent's report.

# Board Recognition/Awards

Dr. Forsthoffer recognized that tonight was the last meeting for Mr. Donnadio and Mrs. Hewitt since they were not seeking re-election and thanked them for their service to the Board of Education.

Mr. Blandino recognized the high school baseball team. He also thanked Mr. Donnadio and Mrs. Hewitt for their service to the Board of Education.

Dr. Paget thanked Mrs. Hewitt for representing Millstone and Mr. Donnadio for his service to Hillsborough.

# **Board Committee Reports**

#### Facilities Committee

Mr. Blandino, facilities committee chairperson, stated that the facilities committee met on March 22, 2010 and discussed the awarding of the facilities management bid to Aramark, a county-wide energy audit, a trench near the high school baseball field, and the results of water tests at Woodfern Elementary School.

# Policy Committee

Dr. Rosenberg, policy committee chairperson, stated that the policy committee did not meet.

# Personnel Committee

Dr. Sargent, personnel committee chairperson, stated that the personnel committee met on March 12, 2010 and discussed a proposal by a 9-12 supervisor and a sick bank request.

# Somerset County Educational Services Commission

Dr. Sargent, board representative for the Somerset County Educational Services commission, noted that she attended their meeting last week. She stated that this commission runs an alternative school for some of the most at risk students in Somerset County. Dr. Sargent mentioned that one of the innovative programs that the school has is to run a Quick Check store

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within the school. She also stated that the commission is looking to rent classroom space in some of the districts in the county as a way of bringing some of the needy students back into a more general education type of setting.

# Strategic Planning Committee

Mr. Donnadio, strategic planning committee chairperson, stated that the committee has not met.

# Negotiations Committee

Mr. Hudes, negotiations committee chairperson, stated that the committee met separately with the Hillsborough Education Association and the Principals and Supervisor's association to discuss the 2010-11 budget. He said that the committee also met with the 9-12 supervisors as part of the mediation process.

# Finance Committee

Mr. Gillette, finance committee chairperson, stated that the finance committee met several times before the March 22, 2010, board meeting to help finalize the 2010-11 tentative budget that was voted on during that meeting.

# **Communications Committee**

Mrs. Haas, communications committee chairperson, stated that the committee met on April 7, 2010, and discussed budget negotiations and will have a budget newsletter and a "Frequently Asked Questions" newsletter going out this week. She stated that the committee also discussed the district website and the upcoming presentation.

#### Curriculum Committee

#### No report

Time was allowed for questions and comments on committee reports.

Dr. Paget stated that he served as former board representative for the Somerset County Educational Services commission and asked about a work training program at the school that they were working on.

Dr. Sargent stated that they have done this by forming a partnership with the Somerset County Vocational/Technical School to share course work and also through the running of the Quick Check store.

## Presentation

Dr. Forsthoffer introduced Leonore Johnston, director of special services for the district. Mrs. Johnston stated that April is Autism Awareness Month and introduced Kathleen Kaminski, behavior specialist with the district. Ms. Kaminski explained what autism is and that the rate of autism worldwide is one in one hundred and ten while in New Jersey, the rate is one in ninety-seven. She then gave a brief history of the autism program in Hillsborough.

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Ms. Kaminski then introduced Viktoria Wargo, special education teacher, who gave a video presentation on Autism Awareness. Ms. Wargo then introduced Briana Delvecchio who is the sister of a child with autism. Ms. Delvecchio described her journey as a sibling of a child with autism.

Dr. Forsthoffer and Dr. Paget thanked all of this evening's presenters.

Time was allowed for questions and comments on the presentation.

Mr. Hudes stated that if you have ever been in one of the autism classes in the district, you would see a very caring, special group of people working with very special and probably our most needy students. The staff involved with this program has done a tremendous service to the school district, the community, and to the students and their families. He said that the board should be very proud of this program and should continue to support it. He closed by stating that it is a model and an exceptional program.

Dr. Paget asked Mrs. Johnston if the image of the feet in the video presentation were filled out by the regular education students.

Mrs. Johnston said that they were.

Dr. Paget then stated that this is a good example of how the students are in the schools and interacting with the general education students. This allows for the general education students to be familiar with people with autism.

Mrs. Johnston stated that there is a pep rally scheduled for Woodfern Elementary School on Friday where the music program will sing the chorus of the song that was played during the presentation.
