Dear Hillsborough High School Community,

As you are aware from the communication on May 5, 2017, in compliance with the Department of Education regulations, Hillsborough High School's drinking water was tested for lead on April 23, 2017.

Following the original testing that occurred, eight additional outlets were identified and tested on May 22, 2017. The table below identifies the single water outlet that tested at or above the lead action level established by the US Environmental Protection Agency for lead in drinking water (15 µg/l [ppb]).
